Click the **ENTER NOW** button near the top right of the FilmLight Colour Awards web site.

Click **create new entry**.

Select the checkboxes to confirm that you agree to the entry rules, then select the category that you want to enter and click **submit** at the bottom of the page.

The field **Describe Scope of Your Work** is mandatory for all entries. Be as specific as possible. Entries that do not contain a full answer may be at a disadvantage, as it makes it difficult for our jury to assess the contribution of the grade.

Entries that do not complete this section in detail may be excluded from the competition.

For example: at what stage did you get involved; how was the look developed with the DoP and director; what was the colour pipeline; how much time was spent on the grade; were there any particular challenges; did you collaborate with other departments?

When you have filled in the entry form, click **submit**.



You will have the chance to edit the form and add further information later before your entry is finalised.

H264 files are also accepted.

Before your entry can be finalised, you need to upload the video file.

Click **Choose file** to upload your project video. The preferred upload format is ProRes HQ, but H.264 files are also accepted. Click **upload** after you have selected the file.

You can also choose to upload the video file later.



You will be warned if your file doesn't meet the required specifications. See [Technical Specifications](#) for more details.

You must complete all required information for the entries highlight

Once you have added the video file (or chosen to add it later) you will see the pending entries screen. From here, you can edit the entry form, add or update supporting materials or before/after shots or delete the entry.

The Status column gives you an indication of the steps that you need to complete before you can finalise the entry.

If you need to add the project video to an entry, or update the video file, click **Edit**, then scroll to the bottom of the page and click **add file**.



Supporting materials are strongly recommended for all categories.

finalize entry



Once you are happy with your entry, you must click **finalize entry** to submit it to the competition.

You will then receive a confirmation email - make sure that you save the email for future reference.



If you have not received a confirmation email with an entry record attached to it, double-check that you have actually finalised your entry.

What happens next?

Entries close on July 31. After this date, the FilmLight Colour Awards jury will review all of the submitted projects.

The awards shortlist will be announced in the middle of October. Entrants who succeed in making the shortlist will be notified before the public announcement.
